## COMPETENCIAS

C2	Can understand with ease virtually everything heard or read. Can summarise information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. Can express him /herself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations.
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Listening: I have no difficulty in understanding any kind of spoken language, whether live or broadcast, even when delivered at fast native speed, provided I have some time to get familiar with the accent.

Reading: I can read with ease virtually all forms of the written language, including abstract, structurally or linguistically complex texts such as manuals, specialised articles and literary works.

Spoken Interaction: I can take part effortlessly in any conversation or discussion and have a good familiarity with idiomatic expressions and colloquialisms. I can express myself fluently and convey finer shades of meaning precisely. If I do have a problem I can backtrack and restructure around the difficulty so smoothly that other people are hardly aware of it.

Spoken production: I can present a clear, smoothly-flowing description or argument in a style appropriate to the context and with an effective logical structure which helps the recipient to notice and remember significant points.



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Writing: I can write clear, smoothly-flowing text in an appropriate style. I can write complex letters, reports or articles which present a case with an effective logical structure which helps the recipient to notice and remember significant points. I can write summaries and reviews of professional or literary works.

## PROGRAMA

Students in this course will have the opportunity to practise the different skills involved in any language like reading, listening, speaking or writing. Furthermore, lexical and grammatical areas that are relevant at a C2-level will be dealt with. The course will also include a teaching module where students will be able to discover some aspects of teaching languages.

The following are some examples of the content areas which will be covered in the course:

Lexical Areas i.e. Phrasal verbs

Grammar structures i.e. Conditionals

Communication skills i.e. task completion during role playing

Classroom English (Teaching Module): This module deals with lesson planning and classroom dynamics and provides students with the language and strategies they need to teach a brief class in English; it is worth 20% of the final grade for the subject.

The overall objective of this course is to provide students with the grammatical and vocabulary knowledge, as well as the reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, required for successful completion of a standardized C2-level exam (Cambridge First or EOI).

The classes will draw on published materials and online resources meant for that language level, and will involve active participation on the students' part.

## EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

A wide range of different exercises, activities and tasks will be used both in the classroom and outside the classroom to help students achieve a C2-level in English.

## **EVALUACIÓN**

This course has 6 ECTS, which implies up to 150-180 hours of work on the students' part, including attending lessons, doing exams and working outside the classroom.

The final exam will take about 2.5 hours, classtime will imply about 40 hours, so you are expected to work on your own for about 100 hours in the semester (from 1st September until the day of the final exam).

**Final written exam: 30%** (including Grammar and Vocabulary 10%, Listening 10% and Reading 10%)

**Final oral exam: 10%**

## DATES

Midterm exam (October 2023). To cover first half of subject material.

No continuous assessment tasks to be assigned after week of 10 November 2022.

Final exam (December 2023).

## RE-SIT EXAMINATION PERIOD

Those students who have failed the course in the first semester (i.e., they have less than 50% in the total of the exams and assessments of the course).

**The re-sit examination will consist of an exam with the following components:**

Grammar and Vocabulary, Reading, Writing (TWO essays), Listening and Speaking

The coursework and test done during the semester WILL NOT be considered for that grade in June 2024.

Those students who have already passed the course in December 2023 and want to raise their final grade, they will have the opportunity to do so in June 2024.



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**They will have to sit an exam with the following components:**

Grammar and Vocabulary, Reading, Writing (TWO essays), Listening and Speaking

The results obtained in that exam will appear in the academic record in June 2024 (segunda convocatoria), even if they are worse than the ones in December 2023.
