THE SPANISH PROGRAM: GOALS

The three primary goals of the program are:

- (1) Developing **oral and written communicative abilities in Spanish**.
- (2) Understanding the rich **culture** of the Spanish-speaking world through varied texts and cultural artifacts.
- (3) Studying and understanding the **Spanish language**, from grammar and orthography to writing with coherence, cohesion, and accuracy.

PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH

- The program focuses on the development of written and oral communicative abilities in Spanish through an interactive activity-based approach. Courses are based on active learner participation. Students are expected to engage in interactive small and large-group activities. The different tasks presented in class will require students to



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use Spanish in multiple situations that reflect the use of different varieties of Spanish. Assessment is based on both your ability to use the language in written and oral tasks and on your knowledge and understanding of Spanish language and culture.

- 20 % - 2 Scenarios (2 oral exams)
- 20 % - Logros 1 (midterm exam)
- 30% - Logros 2 (final exam)

OTHER GENERAL RULES

ADAPTACIONES (Academic Accommodations)

Students in need of academic accommodations should talk to their [studies coordinator](#). Instituto de Idiomas cannot retroactively implement accommodations for students who have not previously informed the Director of Programs of Instituto de Idiomas of their needs.

DISPOSITIVOS ELECTRÓNICOS (electronic devices)

Cell Phone, Laptop Tablets, or any electronic device in the Classroom: Please be courteous and turn off your cell phone before the start of each class. We also request that you *do not use a laptop computer during class without expressly being invited to do so by your Instructor* (e.g., during a Writing Workshop). Your full attention needs to be committed to communicating in Spanish with your teacher and classmates during each class.

FECHAS DE EVALUACIÓN (assessment dates)



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As a general rule, exams and tests will not be rescheduled. In case of illness, the student must present an official medical certificate (specifying that the illness prevents the student from attending class on the date of the test). In case the test coincides with an important appointment (medical appointment, embassy or police appointment, etc.), an official receipt stating the date and time of the appointment will also be required. If these documents are presented, the Instituto de Idiomas board will consider the possibility of rescheduling. The simple presentation of a voucher does not necessarily guarantee a change of date. In no case will exam and test dates be changed to accommodate student travel. Other cases and particular situations will be discussed within the Instituto de Idiomas board.

IMPORTANT: To be able to make up an exam or other material if the student is absent that day, they must 1) notify the professor in advance if they will not attend the class and 2) provide a justification (official documentation) and turn it in as soon as possible.
