COMPETENCIES/OBJECTIVES

Here are the objectives to reach at the B2 level English course:

Listening:

Student can understand extended speech and lectures and follow even complex lines of argument provided the topic is reasonably familiar. He / She can understand most TV news and current affairs programmes and the majority of films in standard dialect.

Reading:

Student can read articles and reports concerned with contemporary problems in which the writers adopt particular attitudes or viewpoints and can understand contemporary literary prose.

Spoken Interaction:

Student can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible. He/She can take an active part in discussion in familiar contexts, accounting for and sustaining his/her views.

Spoken Production:

Student can present clear, detailed descriptions on a wide range of subjects related to my field of interest. He /She can explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

Writing:



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Student can write clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects related to his /her interests. He / She can write an essay or report, passing on information or giving reasons in support of or against a particular point of view and write letters highlighting the personal significance of events and experiences.

PROGRAM

There will be two 90-minute sessions per week.

There will be a continuous assessment involving , written work, consolidation exercises in the student and/or workbook, student's participation in class and a final examination, including oral exams.

The final mark will be awarded according to the results obtained in all sections of the course.

A minimum of 4-5 hours of self-study per week is highly recommended to obtain the B2 level of English.

EVALUATION

- 10% = Individual presentation (Students present a theme/hobby/interest orally and in writing)
- 20 % = Oral (FCE style parts 2 &3)
- 15% Writings x3 = 15%
- 55% Final examination. (reading, grammar, vocabulary, and listening)
