



PRESENTACIÓN

Breve descripción: This subject is devoted to the study of the European Union (EU) and its politics. Although the EU can be studied from purely theoretical or practical debates, this course intends to show the importance of ideas in real world examples. The subject has three main aims. First, it aims to review the historical process of EU construction and the main theories explaining it. Second, it aims to present the political dynamics and decision-making processes of the EU by examining the most relevant recent political events. Finally, it aims to explore the main policy areas in the EU.
